How To Use?

Power On: Hold the power button for one second until a square appears on the remote's screen.

Activate Buzzers: Press each buzzer once. They will light up in red.

Start: Click the start button. The buzzers will turn green, indicating they are ready for use. Click on the start button after every question to reset.

Mute Sound: Click on the mute button to mute the buzzer sound.

Continue: Click the continue button to lock the first buzzer and allow other teams to join.

Battery status: Click on the battery button to know the status of the charge left in the buzzers. Full, 80%, 40%, Low

Random Selection: Hold "Stop" and click "Start" to begin random blinking. Press "Battery" to select a buzzer. Click "Start" to reset it or "Continue" to lock the selected buzzer and choose another.

Buzzer Charging and Remote Battery: The buzzers light up when charging and turn off when fully charged. To extend the life of your equipment, recharge it every two months. The remote uses two AAA batteries.

Troubleshoot:

- Ensure buzzers are charged if they don't light up.
- If buzzers flash red and green, check the remote's batteries.
- If a buzzer doesn't respond to remote commands, reset it using the "Mode" button as described below.

Ensure all buzzers are off. Turn on the remote and press "Mode" to display "0" on the screen. Use "Continue" and "Mute" to select a buzzer number (1-8), then press "Start" and immediately tap the buzzer four times quickly. If successfully programmed, the buzzer will flash green. Press "Mode" to exit. If it doesn't flash, close the remote and buzzer and try again.
